## REPORT FRAUD, WASTE, & ABUSE

The OIG maintains a Hotline to facilitate the reporting of allegations of fraud, waste, mismanagement, or misconduct in the U.S. Department of Commerce programs or operations. The Hotline complaint form is available online. Issues that are reported include:

- Contract, procurement, and grant fraud
- Misuse of electronic media
- Product substitution, including delivery of substandard supplies and services
- Bribery, kickbacks, and gratuities
- False statements and false claims
- Conflicts of interest and ethics violations
- Harassment or discrimination
- Other whistleblower issues
