He specializes in the study of organized crime and corruption, specifically in international sport. He is one of the world's foremost experts on match fixing and corruption in international sports. Hill obtained his doctorate in Sociology at the University of Oxford.

Declan Hill has written journal articles, a book called *The Fix* and an academic book *Insider's Guide to Match-Fixing in Football* to explain the new phenomenon of globalization and match-fixing in professional sports.

## More

Among others, Chris has taken part in the European Commission's working group to detect match-fixing in Sports Betting. Written reports on suspicious matches used in court cases in Sweden and CAS and developed software to detect suspicious odds movements and behaviour.
